### Understanding the World

We will be continuing to watch the progress of our 100 day potatoes, and planting beans in the garden. We are hoping that the sunflowers and seed bombs which we planted last term will begin to grow. We will also be using the Beebots and learning how to make them move around a map.

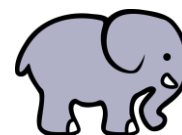


### Communication and Language

We practice our speaking and listening skills every morning during Welcome Time! This term we will also be developing our oral storytelling skills as we listen to and retell a range of traditional and contemporary stories. We will continue to share our ideas and learning with our partners, and practice feeding back their ideas to the group.

### Religious Education

In RE we will be following the Discovery RE programme, using fables and stories from different cultures to learn some moral life messages.



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be thinking about our relationships and friendships, and what it means to be a good friend. We will be thinking about our feelings and emotions and learning strategies to self-regulate and calm ourselves down.

### Welly Wednesdays

On our Welly Wednesday afternoons this term we will be taking story telling outside, using the story of Stick Man to inspire our learning.



### Literacy

This term we will be applying our growing phonic knowledge to writing our own versions of some familiar stories as well as captions and labels for our models. We will discover how stories are constructed by sequencing events and drawing story maps. We will be encouraged and challenged in our reading by the range of books in our classroom.



### Physical Development

Our PE Planning unit for this term is based on music and movement and we will be using our bodies to explore and express the excitement of stories such as Happy Feet and Finding Nemo! We will also be concentrating on good letter formation in our story writing.



### Mathematics

In Mathematics: Numbers we will be solving practical problems of sharing and halving, counting in 2s and 10s, and thinking about the concept of equivalency.

In Mathematics: Shape, Space and Measure we will be starting to tell the time in whole hours, sequencing familiar events, and applying our knowledge of shape and size to building castles and bridges on a large and small scale.



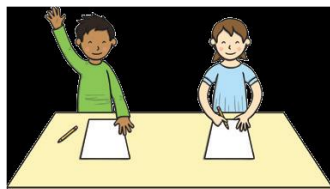
### Expressive Art and Design
