WOW – Sir Teachalot

On the 24th June Sir Teachalot will be visiting Charvil and teaching us more about The Romans!

Computing – Pupils will investigate how computer networks work. They will use a simulation and learn some simple command prompt (C:) tools for testing network connections.

RE –

We are learning to understand different ways that Sikhs show their commitment to God, comparing their practices in order to explore which shows the most commitment.

Music – We will be looking at structure of music and linking this to our science, looking at bones in the body.

French – We will be focusing on animals and learning different colours in order to describe the animals.

Art – Artistic skills

We will be creating Roman Soldier shields and Roman pottery.

Topic – The Romans

We will be carrying on our Roman topic by looking at:

The Roman Gods and goddesses, Emperors, Roman roads and Roman baths.

English

Our English topics will try to include our theme.

We will be writing:

- Newspaper reports reporting an event in the Roman times.
- Shape poetry based on Roman artefacts.

Maths

Our Year 3 objectives this term will include:

- Drawing 2-D shapes and making 3-D shapes using modelling materials; recognising 3-D shapes in different orientations and describing them
- Being able to measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml)

Science – Animals including humans

What we will cover:

- Types of nutrition
- Amount of nutrition needed
- Types of skeletons
- Naming the bones
- Functions of a skeleton
- Learning about the muscles
