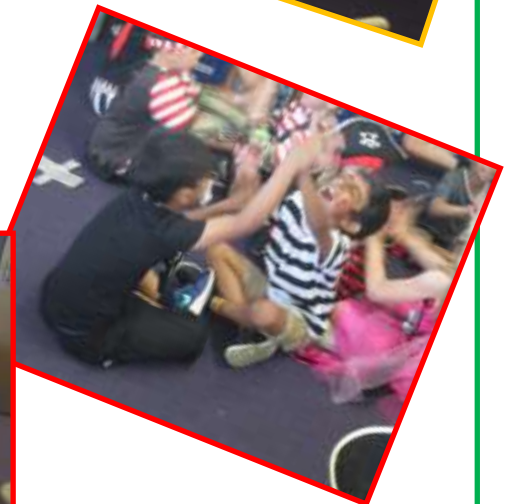
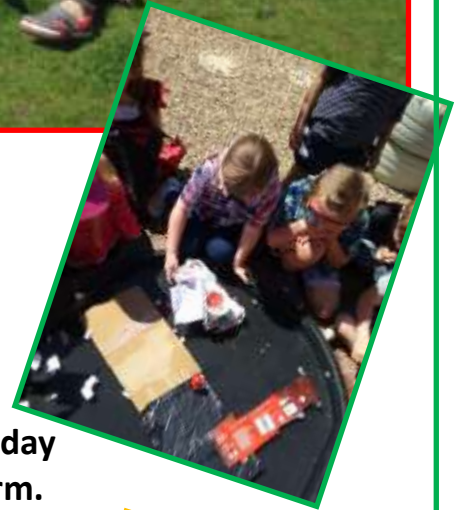





Arhhh Pirates Day

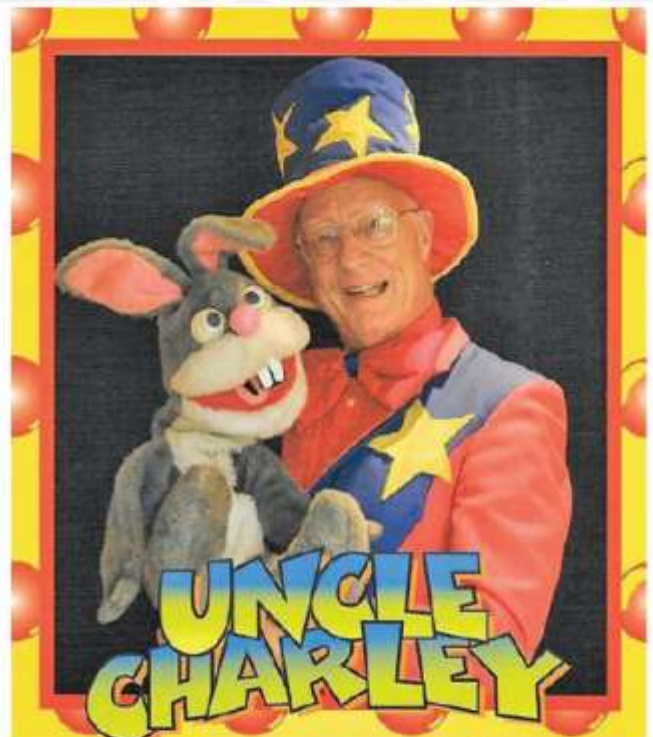
East Park Farm Pavilion
