As part of our complementary studies programme, students in Year 12 will be spending the afternoon at the Hexagon Theatre, Reading watching a presentation entitled 'Safe Drive Stay Alive'. This event was first organised during 2005 and was highly successful as it addressed Road Safety in a manner which really gave students an insight into the implications of dangerous driving. The production reflects on and shows incidents that could occur in real life through film and stage. It is particularly pertinent as many students in Year 12 will be looking to take their driving tests in the coming year and safety is absolutely paramount and raising awareness at this stage is crucial. Statistics indicate that 17-22 year olds make up 4% of the driving population but account for over 30% of the accidents that happen on our roads every year.
