Students will have received their Statement of Entries for the summer 2019 exams. It shows a summary of the examinations that they will take in the summer. Students have been advised of the following:

YEAR 11 & 13 STATEMENT OF ENTRY (SoE) – SUMMER 2019 EXAMS

- the Statement of Entry is an important reference document: keep it safe.
- **It comprises GCE, GCSE, BTEC, Cambridge Technical (CTEC) qualification entries, and all re-sit entries. It does not include 1st4Sport or City & Guilds qualifications.**

***IMPORTANT* Things to check:**

- 'Date of Birth' – is this correct?
- 'Name on Certificates' – must be your formal, legal given name.
- 'Entries' – listed in alphabetical order by Exam Board (AQA, Edexcel, OCR).

***IMPORTANT* Action required:**

- If anything is incorrect or missing, please tell your tutor/subject teacher straight away or come and see Mrs Middleton in the main office – bring your Statement of Entry with you.
- If anything is unclear to you, please talk to your tutor/subject teacher straight away, and come and see Mrs Middleton if there is still an issue.
- If everything is present and correct, no action is required.
- If you have a clash of exams, no action is required now: clashes will be known and dealt with by Mrs Middleton once entries have been confirmed, and you will be informed of arrangements after Easter.
