His objective was to foster physical and psychological development in children through judo.

At Judo School we deliver judo either as an extracurricular activity or in some cases as a part of a school's own sports programme.

Our regular term time judo lessons are supplemented with school holiday judo camps; inter school training and matches, all of which offer pupils great opportunities to make new connections and friendships through judo.

Mark as head coach and Sensei at the world famous Pinewood Judo Club has made the club central to Judo School's activities.

Judo School coach and ex GBR international Jason Woolerton, together with Oliver Fricker (a current member of the GBR Masters Squad) support him with his coaching responsibilities at Pinewood Judo Club, which is a registered charity.

Many Judo School pupils have become members of the club and taken their judo to national level, we use it regularly as a central venue for our inter school training sessions and matches, it's success at world and Olympic level provides an inspiration to the children who visit.

Our coaches are all registered with the British Judo Association which is recognised by UK Sport and the Government as the national governing body for judo in the UK, they are CRB checked, insured and qualified to a minimum of the government recognised UKCC Level 2 in judo.
