
All lunches are free for children in Foundation and KS1, and for those in receipt of free school meals.

Our Year 4 Class produced some beautiful and creative poetry in their English lessons last week.








Last Wednesday we had a wonderful day of celebration in school to mark the Coronation of Our Majesty, King Charles III.



Year 6 SATS



Potato bags: keep looking after your potato bag: add more compost – it should be about ¾ full now. Keep in a warm, sunny position and water regularly.

I-Spy – Have walk around your garden / allotment/ park: <u>e.g.</u> how many different kinds of grass can you see; something beginning with each letter of the alphabet.

Growing <u>idea</u>: You don't have room for a veg plot at home? You could try buying a grow bag and use it to grow cherry tomatoes / spring onions / lettuce / beetroot. May is the month for sowing seeds – have a try with some bee friendly flower seeds.

Gardens open to the public: Forbury Gardens, Reading; Caversham Court Gardens; Langley Country Park, Slough; Dinton Pasture, Winnersh; NB check website for opening times/car parking charges.

Coronation Container: find a suitable container to fill with compost and add colourful plants. You could "upcycle" e.g. an old chest of drawers, a pair of old boots, an old wheelbarrow and place in your front garden.
